Weekly Spelling

Students use CAL Tutor in the computer lab to increase spelling achievement. Students work at their own pace within a design created by a former Spell Bowl champion.

Pre-recorded words ensure an accurate pronunciation, definitions and sentences are displayed with an option to speak the sentences and definitions. The addition of sentences and definitions fosters vocabulary development.

Tests are instantly graded, the last four test results are displayed with misspelled words highlighted. A report is printed a next test study guide.

The goal is to isolate misspelled words for special study. There are two ways to focus on misspelled words- 1). one misspelled word at a time with result and comparison, 2). Test all misspelled words in a troublesome word file.

Teachers are provide student ranked test results and misspelled words ranked with variations of misspellings. There is much more in the Product Tour.
